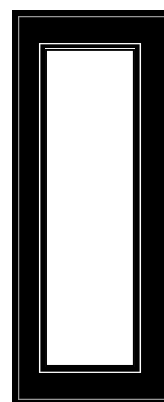
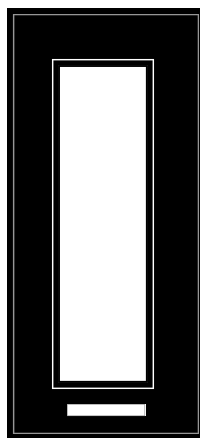




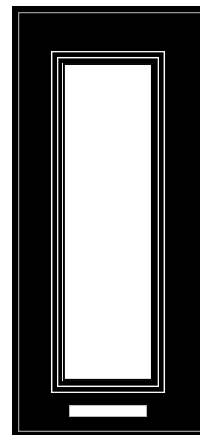

UNDER A WINTER MOON

In 1835, the most infamous of the treaties was negotiated at New Echota, Georgia, the Cherokee capital.
